cooperation between the 10th Directorate of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the 5th Directorate of the State Security Committee of the USSR, 1978-1980.

The state security agencies of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the USSR have detected evidence of the active subversive activities of the enemy's special services and the foreign nationalist, Zionist, reactionary clerical and other anti-socialist subversive centers and organizations of imperialist states associated with them directed against the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the Soviet Union.

In order to further deepen and develop cooperation in the fight against acts of ideological sabotage, special services of the enemy and anti-socialist centers and organizations, the 10th Directorate of the Federal Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the 5th Directorate of the State Security Committee of the USSR, guided by the decisions of the 15th Congress of the Communist Party of Czechoslovakia and the 25th Congress of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union, plan to carry out in the specified period

to carry out specific joint intelligence and operational activities, continuing to direct the main efforts towards intelligence penetration into subversive ideological centers and organizations of imperialist states, uncovering and localizing their hostile activities by compromising both the centers themselves and the leaders and specific executors before the world community: Sb. 5

- Pay special attention to the development of the "Radio Liberty Committee" and "Free Europe", NTS, subversive centers headed by PELICAN, TIGRID and others in accordance with the long-term plan agreed upon at a working meeting in Prague in September 1976. Additionally, seek operational opportunities to acquire agents from among Czechoslovak students studying in the USSR with the aim of using them in activities against "KRS" and NTS.

Conduct preparatory work for holding an international public tribunal in relation to RS/RFE. e S

Intelligence and operational measures against the editorial board of the journal "Continent" and persons actively supporting it are being carried out in accordance with the joint plan developed in April 1976, with particular attention paid to identifying and suppressing illegal channels of communication between the editorial board of "Continent" and antisocial elements in socialist countries. anem

- Continue the implementation of counterintelligence measures envisaged by the long-term plan agreed upon in June 1976 in Kyiv and specified at a working meeting held on September 27 and 28, 1978 in Vysné Nemetske, to develop hostile nationalist organizations and persons associated with them living in the Soviet Union, Czechoslovakia and on the territory of capitalist countries. In this case, it is intended first of all to intensify the development of the reactionary part of the Ukrainian nationalists and persons involved in the cases of "CONGRESS", "FRANKFURT", "ZARYTETS", "EDITOR", "NEPRSHITEL", "MELNYK", "VEDETS", "MAGO" and others. - In developing Zionist and Trotskyist organizations, concentrate efforts on:

Penetration into world Jewish organizations, for which purpose it is intended to use representatives of Jewish religious communities who hold loyal positions with respect to the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the USSR and other socialist countries. In the same direction, to develop emissaries of Zionist organizations and other persons connected with Zionist centers visiting the Soviet Union and Czechoslovakia. To take under special control the work on the cases of "SPLENDID", "VRZIDLO", "AKTIVIST" and others.

To solve the above mentioned tasks, more actively use agents "NOVIKOV", "VOSTOKOV", "MAISKAYA", "TAMARA", "PETER", "NEPOMUTSKY", "HEBREIST" and others. Boveni

Coordinate activities and develop specific tasks for agents to penetrate Trotskyist centers abroad and, above all, the OKI Organization of the Communist International /France/, the GIM group of the International Marxists headed by Jakub MONETOV /FRG/, as well as the GIM in West Berlin.

- Implement joint proposals and find new operational opportunities to create conditions and infiltrate the Vatican, the World Council of Churches, and other reactionary church organizations with the goal of identifying plans and disrupting actions being prepared against the USSR, the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic, and other countries of the socialist community.

Through intelligence, contribute to the deepening of disagreements in the leading international reactionary church circles and, at the same time, develop measures to support progressive forces in this environment.

In resolving these issues, coordinate joint activities on the "SPOYENI" case; continue work to strengthen the position of "PROFESSOR" in the Vatican and create conditions for him to establish contact with the Lviv Vice-Province through

to strengthen work with "POTTER" /WCC/ and other persons, who can influence the policy pursued by this organization, for the interests of the countries of the socialist commonwealth; to assist Bulgarian friends in promoting Professor T. SABEEVA /NRB/ to the post of 3rd Deputy General Secretary of the WCC; to summarize and analyze materials on FISHER, BAUMAN and others, suspected of having ties with the enemy's special services, with the aim of subsequently compromising them before the public.

Through intelligence and other means, continue work to strengthen the position of the Christian Peace Conference (CPC) in the international arena. Use the favorable circumstances that arise to advance the intelligence of the security agencies of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the USSR into foreign centers and special services of the enemy.

Coordinate intelligence and operational measures to intercept the communication channels of emissaries of foreign reactionary sectarian organizations conducting subversive work against the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic, the USSR and other socialist countries.

Develop joint counterintelligence measures to prevent antisocial activities of leaders and active participants of Jehovah's Witnesses, Seventh-day Adventists, Pentecostals and other sects. In doing so, pay special attention to developing sectarian leaders who are attempting to conduct illegal hostile activities.

B. For these purposes, use the agents "Mikhailov", "Petrov" /5th Directorate of the KGB of the USSR/, "Congress" and "Oldřich" /10th Directorate of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic/.

Prepare agents of the 5th Directorate for withdrawal to the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic with the aim of setting them up in Slovakia for the Ukrainian clergy, who maintain close contacts with the Vatican and the Uniate nationalists. Carry out joint activities to study the Uniate priest LYAVINETZ /Czechoslovak Socialist Republic/, who was secretly "ordained" as a bishop by the Vatican and appointed by it as leader of the Uniate underground in Transcarpathia.



- Carry out intelligence and operational measures to suppress attempts by anti-socialist elements in the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic to establish organizational ties with USSR hostile individuals /the so-called "dissidents"/ in the

Conduct joint investigations of Soviet citizens permanently residing in the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and who have entered into criminal relations with representatives of right-wing opportunist elements.

Prepare and carry out /simultaneously/ coordinated measures to compromise the organizers and instigators of hostile actions. In the exposure actions, provide for the use of the agent of the Czechoslovak friends "REPO" /publication in the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic of the book "The Spiral of Treason", preparation of a book on the so-called "dissidence", etc./. Continue the active use of "REPO" in connection with the availability of new opportunities.

Constantly conduct a joint search for new forms and methods of suppressing the hostile activities of anti-socialist elements. ON

- Work to disrupt the enemy's ideological sabotage actions on scientific and cultural exchange channels should be carried out in the direction of identifying and developing individuals who may be used by the enemy for these purposes. Particular attention should be focused on implementing coordinated measures to prevent the blocking of anti-socialist elements on a hostile basis. Intensify joint measures to develop "GRANIN" and "PHILOSOPHER", as well as other individuals in whose study there will be a common interest.

The practice of mutual exchange of information will be - continued about persons expelled from the USSR and the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic for carrying out subversive activities, as well as about representatives of the creative and scientific intelligentsia of capitalist states, the development of whom should be carried out in the direction of using them to disrupt the enemy's ideological sabotage actions;

about scientific, cultural and other organizations and centers used by the enemy's subversive centers

- In order to implement the wishes developed at the meeting in May 1977 in Budapest, to carry out coordinated measures for counterintelligence support and disruption of the enemy's ideological sabotage actions at the following major international forums:

- The 1980 Olympics in Moscow and the Winter Olympic Games in the USA
- 6th International Film Festival of Asian, African and Latin American Countries with the participation of delegations from the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and other socialist countries /Tashkent, 1980/
- Moscow International Book Fair /Moscow, 1979/ -
- Moscow International Film Festival Moscow, 1979 ustanavert year/
- International Congress of Political Sciences /Moscow, August 1979/, odle
- The 7th Summer Spartakiad of the Peoples of the USSR / July 1979/ and other forums by mutual agreement.

Summarize the materials on the use by the enemy for subversive purposes against the USSR, the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and other socialist states of the World Association of Psychiatrists (WAP), the International Association of Philosophical Societies, the World Health Organization (WHO) and the PEN Club. Based on the conclusions, determine measures along the security agencies' lines.

- In the fight against the enemy's ideological sabotage in the area of international student and youth organizations, joint operational efforts will be aimed at identifying and suppressing the hostile influence of the enemy's special services and ideological centers on the International Youth Organizations, the International Union of Students in Prague and the - World Federation of Democratic Youth in Budapest.



Find opportunities to collect materials on the use by the enemy in subversive actions against socialist countries of youth organizations of the FRG /YUSO Young Socialists of the FRG, YUSY Socialist Youth Union of the FRG/, France, England, Italy.

- In joint counterintelligence activities on foreign students from developing countries studying in the USSR and the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic, the greatest attention should be focused on studying the situation in the Union of Kurdish Students in Europe, identifying and suppressing antisocial actions by representatives of extremist organizations of Arab students (Black September, Black June, etc.) 15

Carry out prompt exchange of information on the activities of extremist organizations and on individual extremists who may carry out terrorist and other actions on the territory of the USSR, Czechoslovakia or other socialist countries.

In order to coordinate efforts to ensure the implementation of planned activities, constantly maintain business contacts by organizing working meetings of the department's employees, and also practice holding periodic meetings of delegations at the level of the department's management.

The plan comes into force on the day of its approval by the leadership of the Federal Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic and the KGB of the USSR and is valid
